Daily Screening Procedures for COVID-19 Symptoms*

Please screen your student(s) daily for the following symptoms **BEFORE** sending your student(s) to school each day (Monday through Friday). ** When evaluating the symptoms, consider the following questions:

“Is my student currently experiencing any of the following symptoms, which are not attributable to another medical condition, in a way that is new and not normal for him/her?”

- Feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100 degrees Fahrenheit
- Cough (which is new or unusual)
- Severe headache (which is new or unusual)
- Shortness of breath
- Difficulty breathing
- Loss of taste
- Loss of smell
- Sore throat
- Runny nose
- Fatigue or sudden extreme tiredness
- Body aches or significant body aches
- Diarrhea
- Nausea and/or Vomiting

If your student is symptom-free and you answered **NO** to all symptoms:

Send your student to school as normal and screen again the next school day.

If you answered **YES** because your student has symptoms present:

STOP and DO NOT send your student to school.
