PUBLIC HEARING AEIS REPORT Johnny Clawson, Superintendent, explained the Academic Excellence Indicator System (AEIS) report is information compiled through the PEIMS system regarding the 2011-2012 District performance. He stated the report covers various indicators including but not limited to test scores, attendance, student information, staff information, tax and financial information, etc. Mr. Clawson gave an overview of the District's percentages as compared to the state percentages.

Mr. Clawson gave an update regarding "education on school violence". He stated the District has in place an Emergency Management Program. There is a mandatory drug screening for all personnel who transport students as well as DPS background check on all personnel, substitutes, and volunteers. A random student drug testing program with follow-up counseling takes place every month. The District utilizes Shannon Hernandez as the School Resource Officer. There are various safety trainings offered for staff throughout the year.

Principals High School

Eric Bierman, Principal, thanked the Trustees for their support and dedication to the District. He announced the UIL Academic teams continue with practices. Brady hosted their first UIL Academic Invitational Meet recently and was successful not only as a meet but also the student achievements. The possibility of competing in a state wide "cyber meet" is being researched. Mr. Bierman gave the benchmark test results and the areas of concern and ways to help the students achieve higher marks. He stated attendance is down due to the flu and various illnesses.

Middle School

In the absence of Shona Moore, Principal, Mr. Clawson reported the campus spelling been was conducted and the winners will be participating in the District Spelling Bee February 1. Cheer tryouts will also be February 1. Student Council will be hosting a Valentine's Dance February 8 from 7-10:00 p.m.

Brady Elementary

In the absence of Kelley Hirt, Principal, Mr. Clawson stated STAAR benchmark testing continues. The campus spelling bee was conducted and the winners will participate in the District Spelling Bee February 1. He presented an invitation to the Trustees for a School Board Appreciation Day to be held Thursday, January 31 from 11:30-1:30 p.m. with a lunch provided.

Technology

In the absence of Coty Tidwell, Director, Mr. Clawson stated the technology department has installed 92 computers at Brady Elementary.

Food Service

Sarah Smith, Director, presented the February breakfast and lunch menus. She stated there will be a validation review conducted by TEA. She is in the process of ordering commodities for next year. The District receives approximately \$30,000 from the state to help defer the expense of the commodities. Ms. Smith reported the number of students eating breakfast at the Middle and High School campuses have increased due to Coach Howard involving the athletes.

Athletics

Andy Howard, Director, complimented the staff and coaches for the communication that is necessary for the success of the athletes. Spring sports have begun with practices and meets for both boys and girls. An "accountability team" program has been implemented in the boy's off season program. The girls in off season are participating in a program for strength, flexibility and speed. Upcoming dates include February 14, 2013 Brady will host their power lift meet. February 21 Brady will host the 1st Bulldog Relays. March 21, 2013 is the Heart of Texas Relays for the Middle School and March 23 will be the High School meet.
