Elementary & DAEP

Roof Repair-Brady Mr. Limbaugh explained the elementary, DAEP and the juvenile probation office roofs need to be repaired. He received an estimate from Big Bear Roofing and Construction out of Waco just to get an idea of the cost. This would not replace the roofs only repair them. The money would be taken from the construction fund balance and would not be included in the bond election. Below are estimated costs.

> Elementary only \$115,829 **DAEP & Probation Office** \$34,222 DAEP only \$21,576 **Probation Office only** \$16,932

All members agreed for Mr. Limbaugh to proceed in obtaining other bids for the project.
